California law requires that any person who enters into employment as a child care custodian, health practitioner, or with a child protective agency (county probation department, county welfare department, or police or sheriff's department) must sign a statement acknowledging awareness of hi/her obligations in reporting child abuse. Additionally, any person who acts as a child visitation monitor, prior to monitoring the first visit in a case, must sign a statement acknowledging awareness of his/her obligations in reporting child abuse. The signed statements must be retained by the employer.
